<u>**Cearning Online Timetable**</u>

At the back of this newsletter are two timetables. One for those who are still Te Kākano at Home and those essential/required workers' children commencing Te Kākano at school. Mrs Gabby Nuthall and Miss Emily Langridge will be creating the TK school bubble. If you are coming to school, please adhere to **all** of the guidelines set out by Miss Horn - this keeps our teachers safe as well as your children. The Te Kākano at home timetable follows more of the typical day structure so it is not such a shock when all the children return to school at Level Two. Mr Mark Smith and Miss Kendra Liggett will continue to support the online learning from home.



## Hui Times - New Groups/Times

There are **two** daily hui time groups per Kōhanga. Your child's hui time will either be at **10:00am** or **10:30am** and will continue to be via Zoom (Mrs Nuthall & Miss Langridge will do their times from school). Miss Liggett will do Rarahu's hui times on Fridays. Please look out for a message from your child's kōhanga teacher with a Zoom link and a time.

### Pastoral Care Calls - Level Three

We are aware that you may be receiving multiple channels of communication with many agencies at the moment. In Level Four, it was really important for us to ensure that our families felt well supported by the school and we had a picture of the pastoral care needs of each family. As families move more confidently into schooling from Home, you may not feel the need for a weekly call anymore and may like a pastoral care call on a fortnightly basis instead. If you would like a fortnightly call, please email/Seesaw message your child's kōhanga teacher asap. If we do not hear from you, we will continue to call on a weekly basis. A reminder that these calls are now voice calls and not Zoom meetings.
