L.I.G.H.T.S. Trips - Food Waste Group

Mr Smith's Food Waste class are finding ways to encourage us all to reduce food waste. At the same time we are concerned that whilst the world increasingly wastes food there are countless people starving from lack of food. This unbalance is not right. We visited Ellesmere Food Bank, a well trusted local food bank operator. Run by a lovely, humble christian couple Corry and her husband Daniel, supported by volunteers they make up and distribute 6,000 banana boxes of food each year. They deliver as far as the West Coast - 1 tonne of spuds at a time. We visited their home and shed in Leeston to help out and packaged up boxes of food and unloaded a trailer full of pumpkins. The ute full of potatoes were not accepted by the supermarkets because they were the wrong size so would have been thrown away. We were helping to reduce FOOD WASTE. Yeah!
