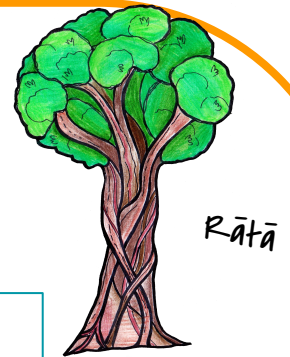

Welcome to Term 4

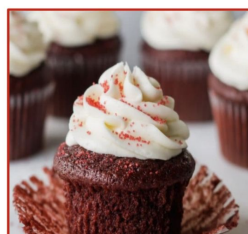

Whanau Athletics Day.



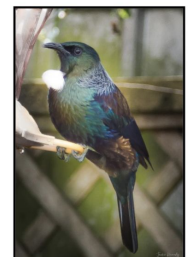

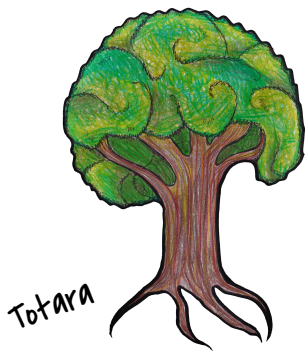
We are having it on Thursday, 28th of October to raise money for bird feeders & Tui Tucker trees. (Week 2)

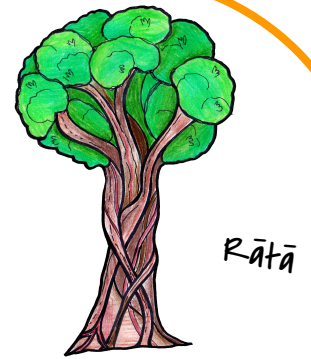
