Last Minute Camp Reminders....

- On Wednesday, be at school at 8.30am. We will leave at 9.15am and have much to do before then.
- On the first day of camp you need to bring a day backpack with your morning tea, lunch, drink bottle, sunscreen, hat, insect repellent. Wear shoes and clothes that are appropriate for physical activity.
- BAKING CONTRIBUTION or BAG OF FRUIT are needed from each child

This is for morning and afternoon teas. This will be handed in to the kitchen for shared morning and afternoon teas on Thursday and Friday, (and suppers if there is enough).

- Your drink bottle will be your cup don't forget it!
- If you would prefer not to get your feet wet, bring gumboots for the river.
- Any medication should be placed in a plastic bag, named and with instructions and handed to your child's teacher. There are sandflies and wasps in the area, so if your child reacts to bites or stings, please provide antihistamine.
- We will return by 3pm on Friday.
- Mr Mark Smith will also be coming on camp with us.
- No cell phones or digital devices are to be brought on camp by students.
