If you are coming to school, please adhere to **all** of the guidelines set out by Miss Horn - this keeps our teachers safe as well as your children. The Te Kākano at home timetable follows more of the typical day structure so it is not such a shock when all the children return to school at Level Two. Mr Mark Smith and Miss Kendra Liggett will continue to support the online learning from home.



Hui Times - New Groups/Times

We have been running 4 hui times a day over Level 4 in order to give your children an opportunity to see the teacher regularly. We have found this time to be successful and would like to continue to provide this opportunity during Level Three.

There will be **two** daily hui time groups per Kōhanga starting from Wednesday 29th April (no hui times this Monday/Tuesday),

Your child's hui time will either by at **10:00am** or **10:30am** and will continue to be via Zoom (Mrs Nuthall & Miss Langridge will do their times from school). Miss Liggett will do Rarahu's hui times on Fridays. Please look out for a message from your child's kōhanga teacher with a Zoom link and a time.

Pastoral Care Calls - Level Three
