Students for the Cultural Day Celebration have been preparing lesson plans and ensuring they communicate to their peers on the day in a clear manner.

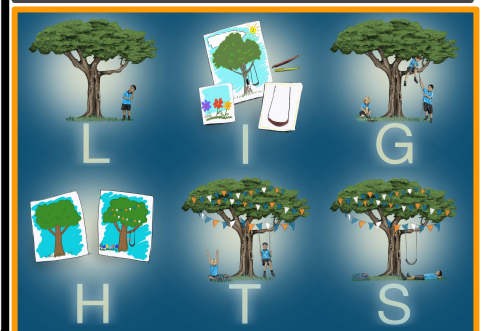
So much preparation goes into these projects - we are all excited, prepared & slightly tired!
