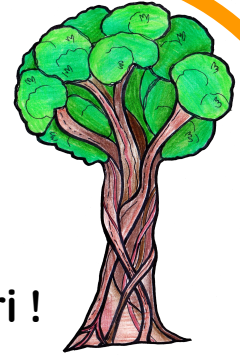


Te Mahuri Hub Newsletter
